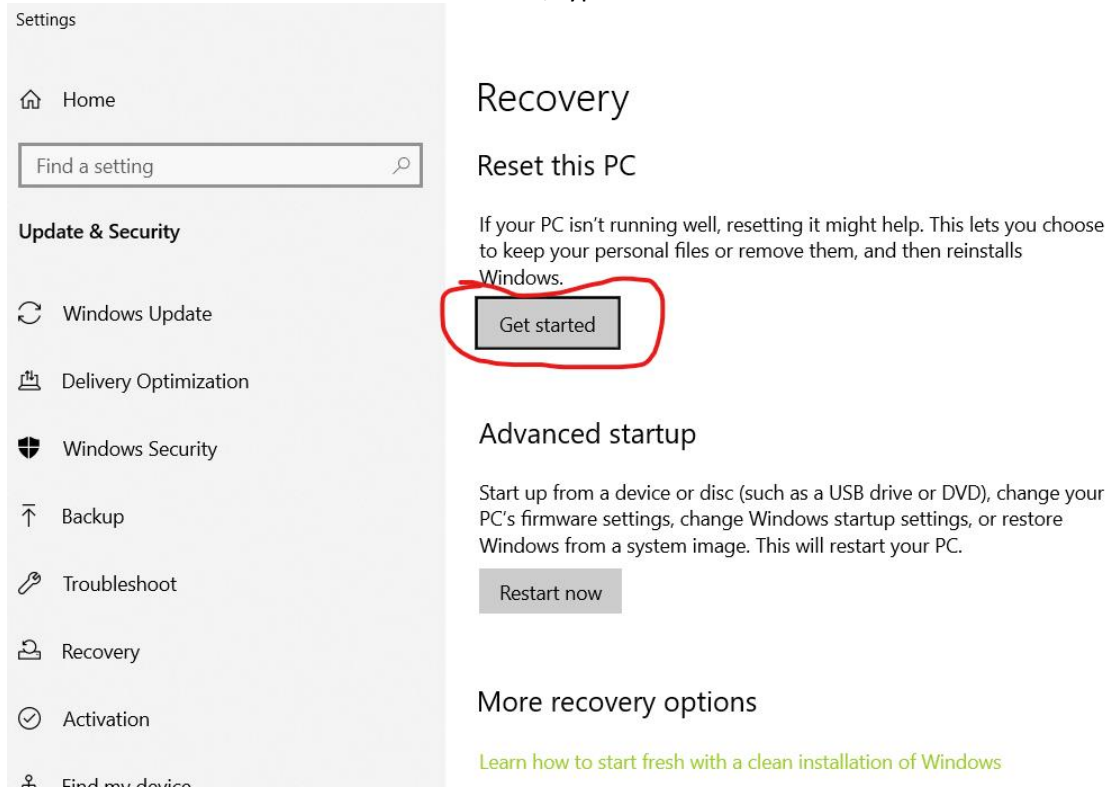
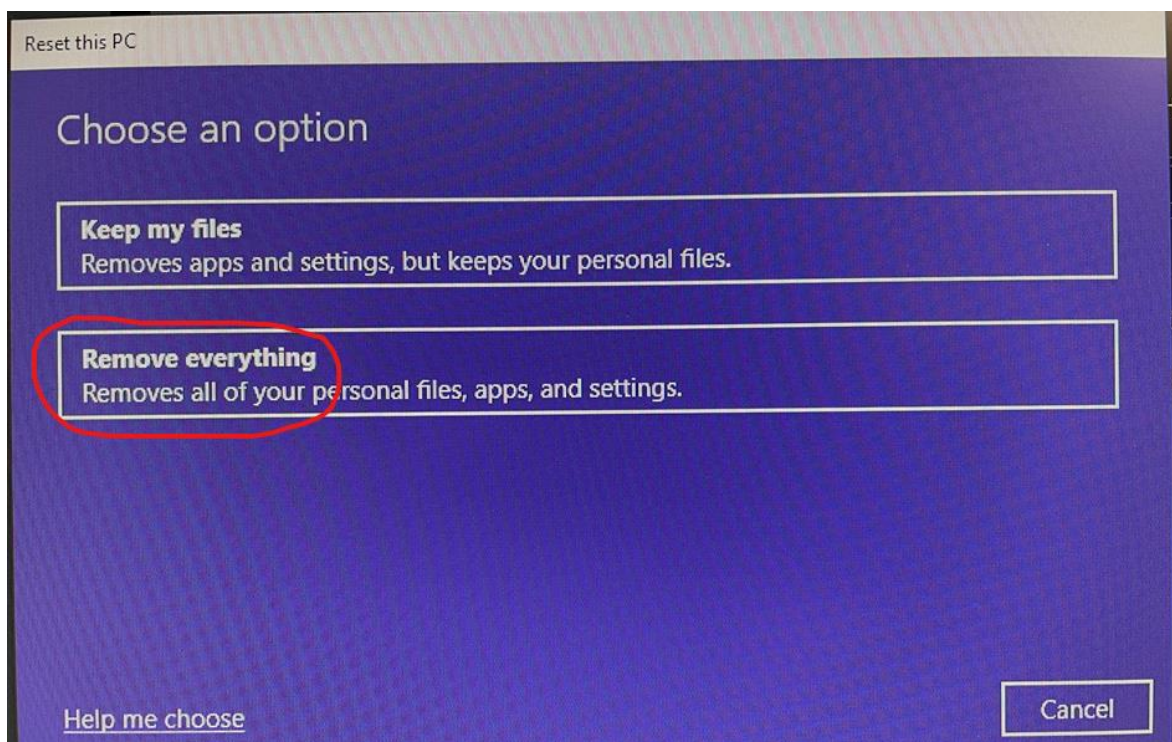


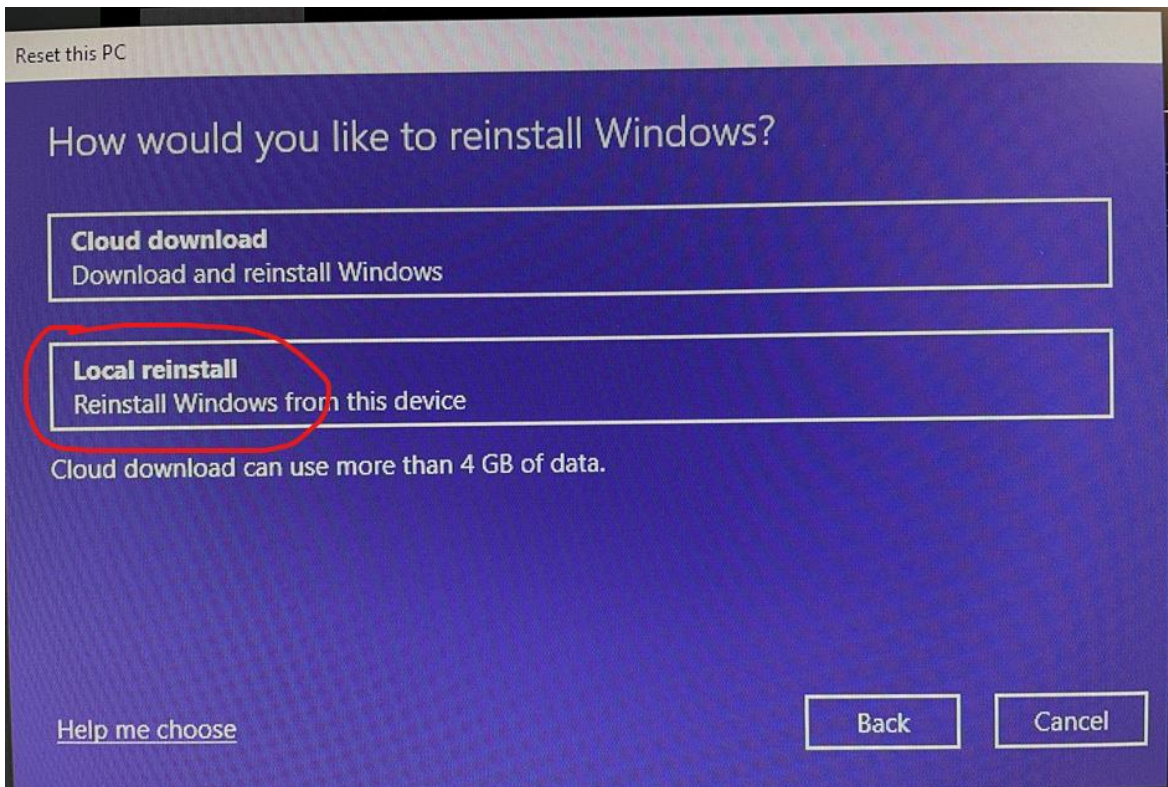
- 1) In the Windows search bar in the bottom left, type in "Reset" and hit enter



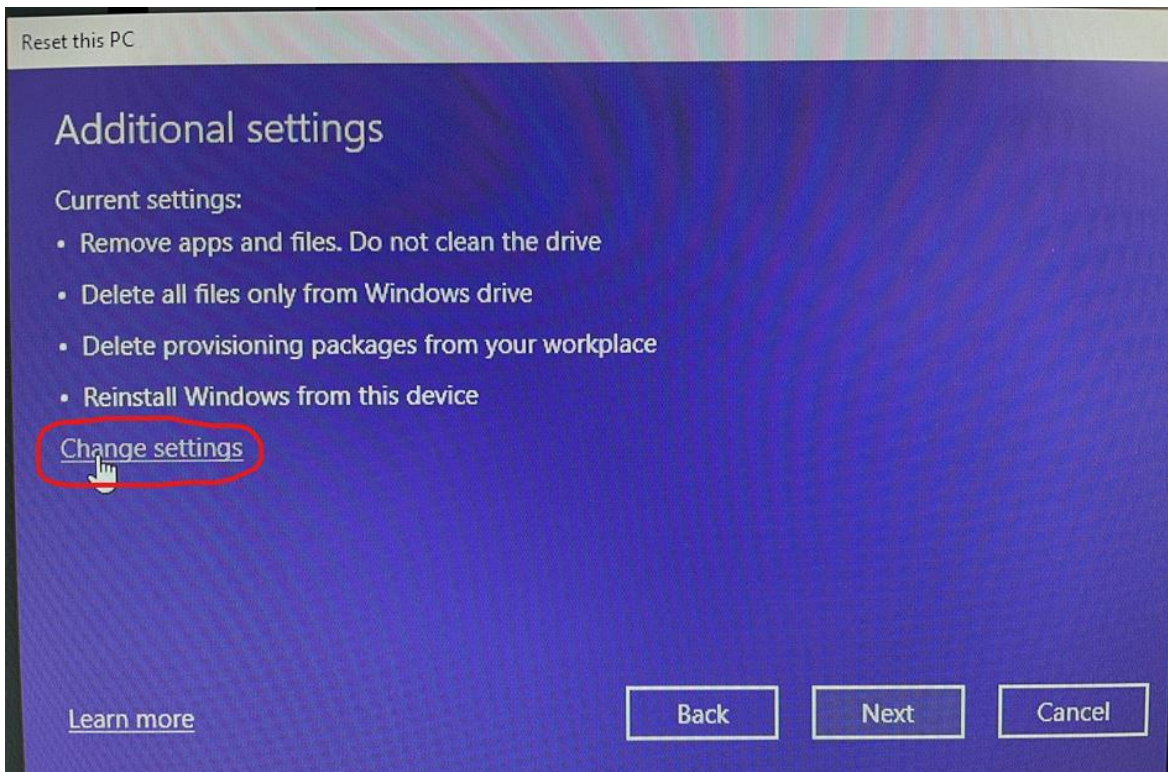

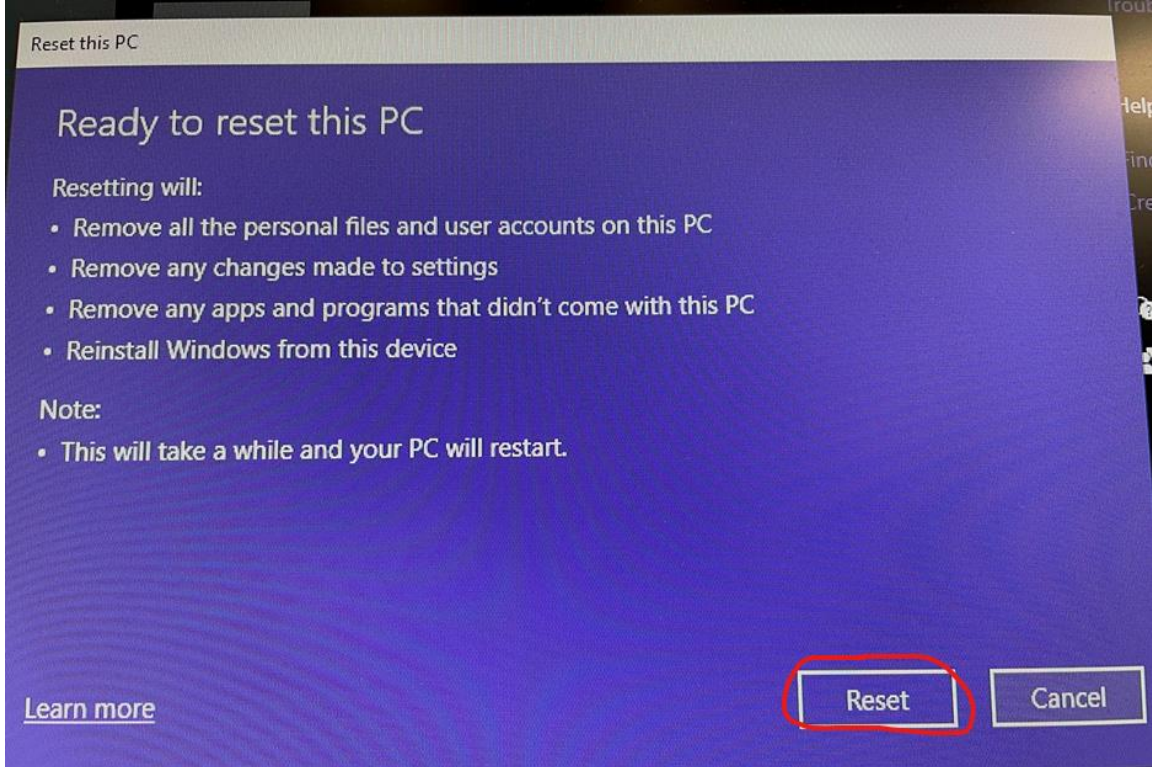
6) Now set the options on the screen for a thorough reset, as such



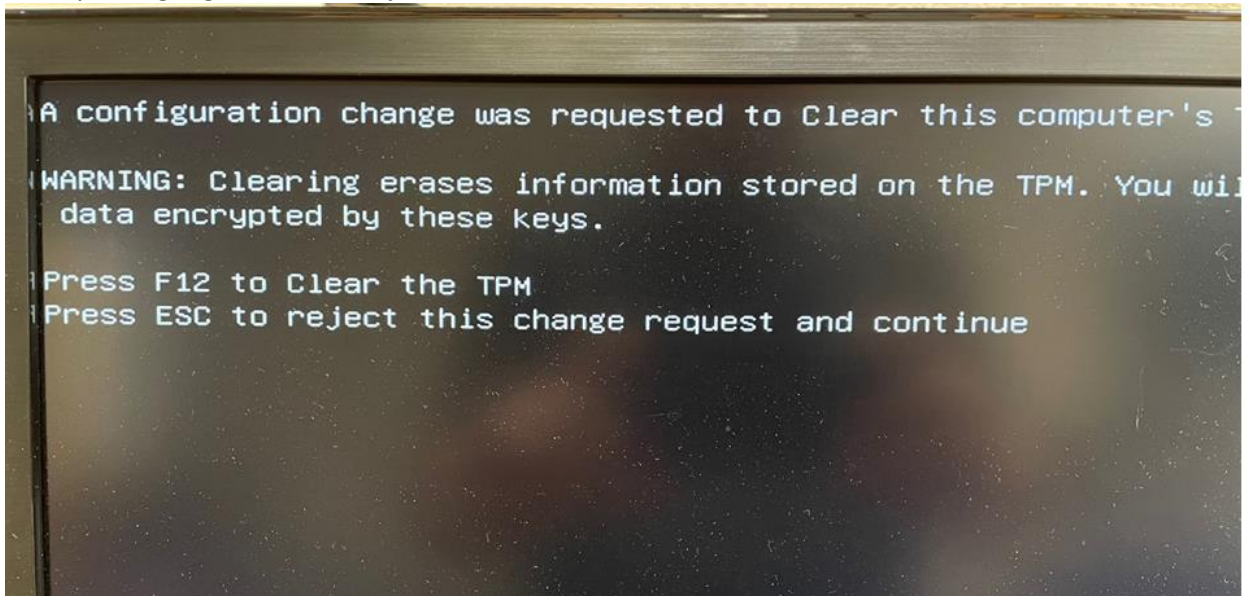
7) Now you're back to this screen, it's just confirming your changes, click Next



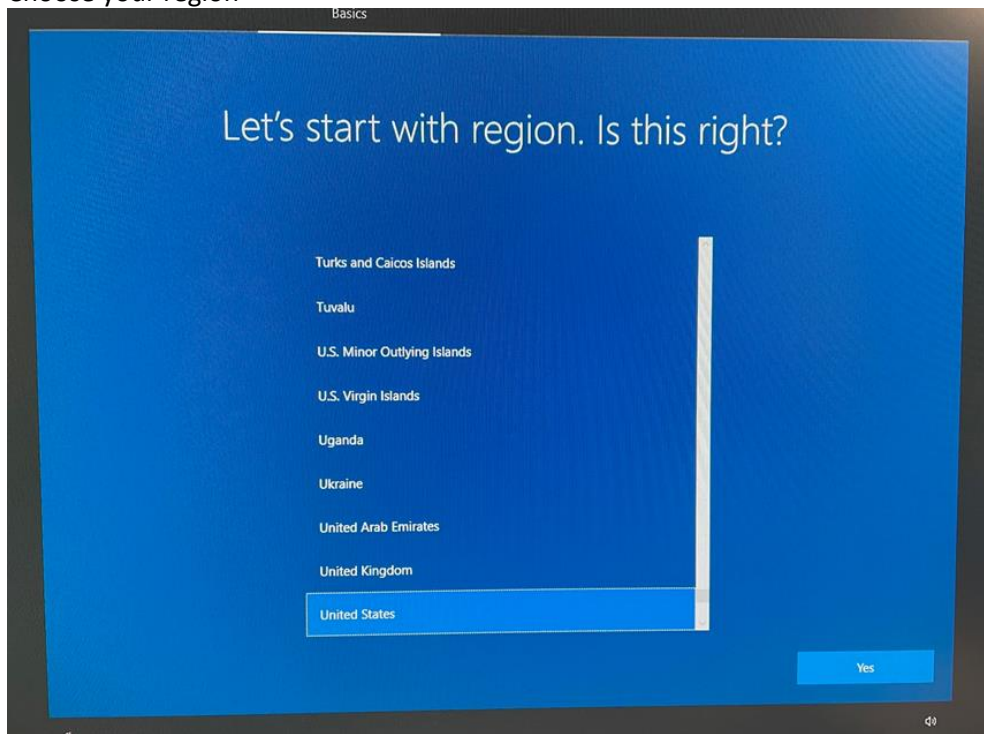
- 8) It's ready to reset now, click Reset (The reset process may take 1-2 hours depending on hard drive size)



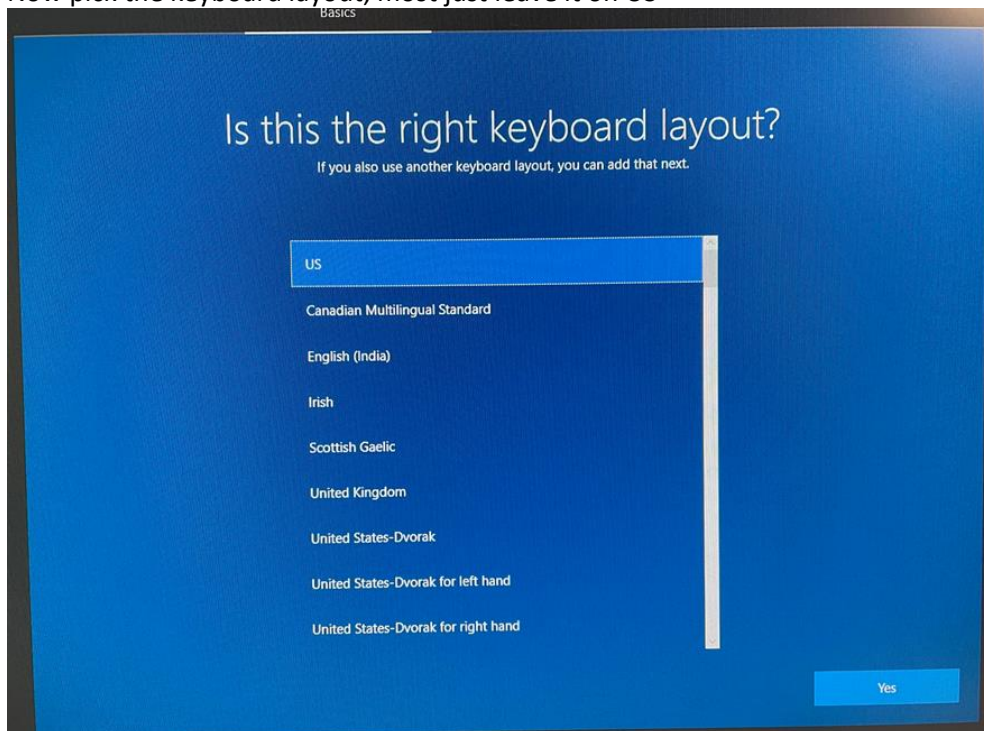
- 9) Next, you might get this screen, just hit F12



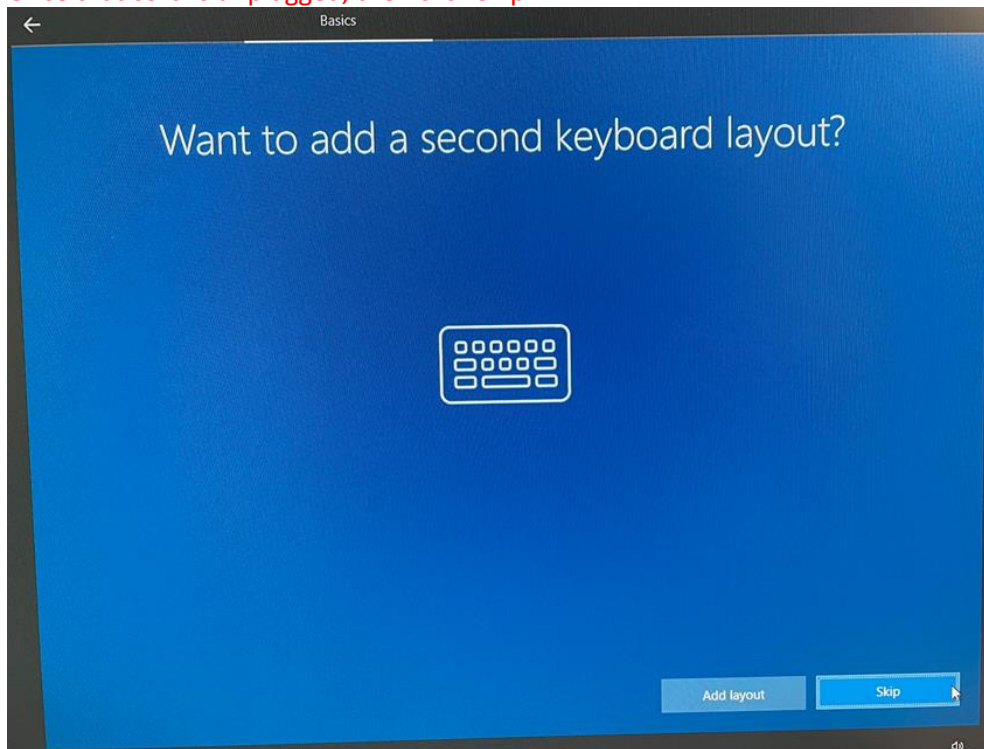
10) Choose your region



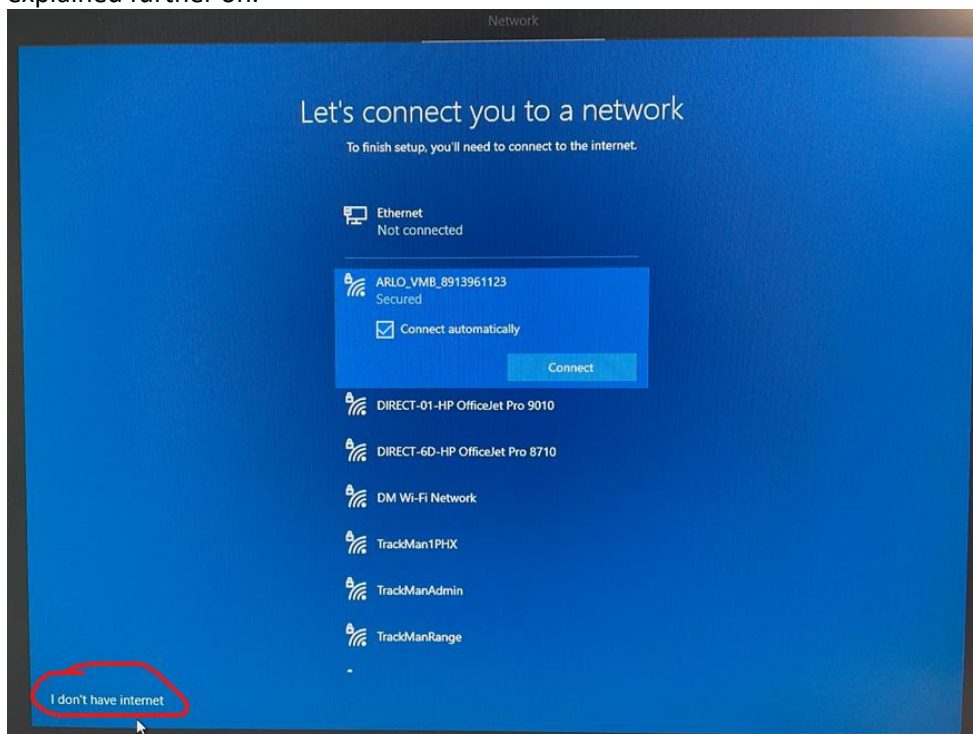
11) Now pick the keyboard layout, most just leave it on US



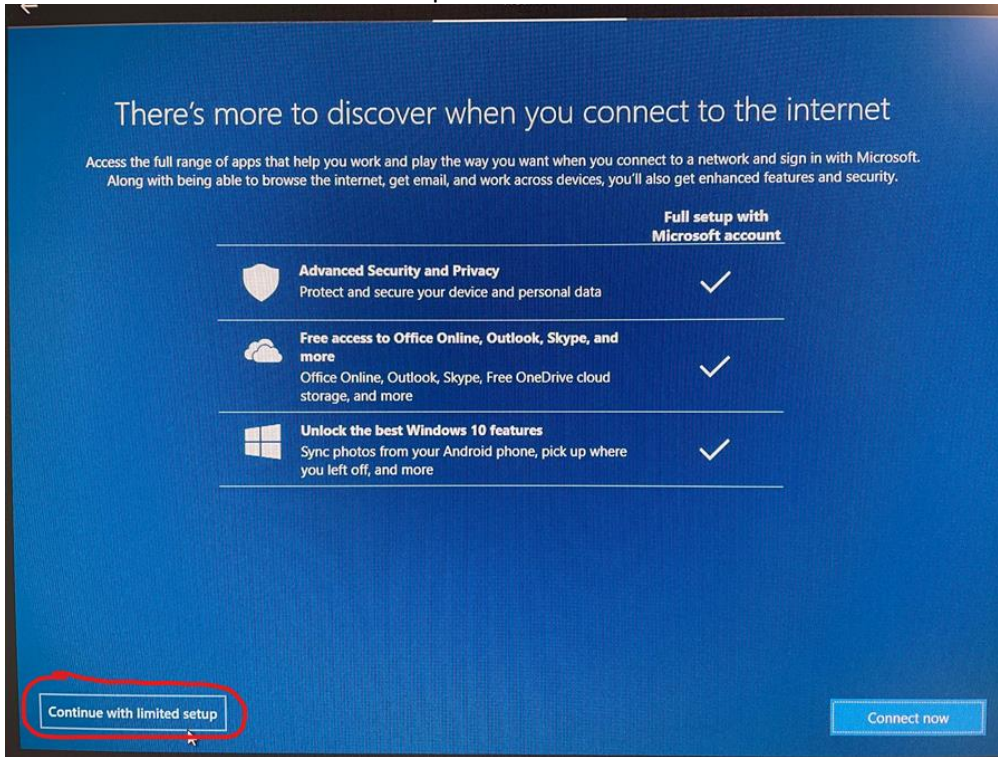

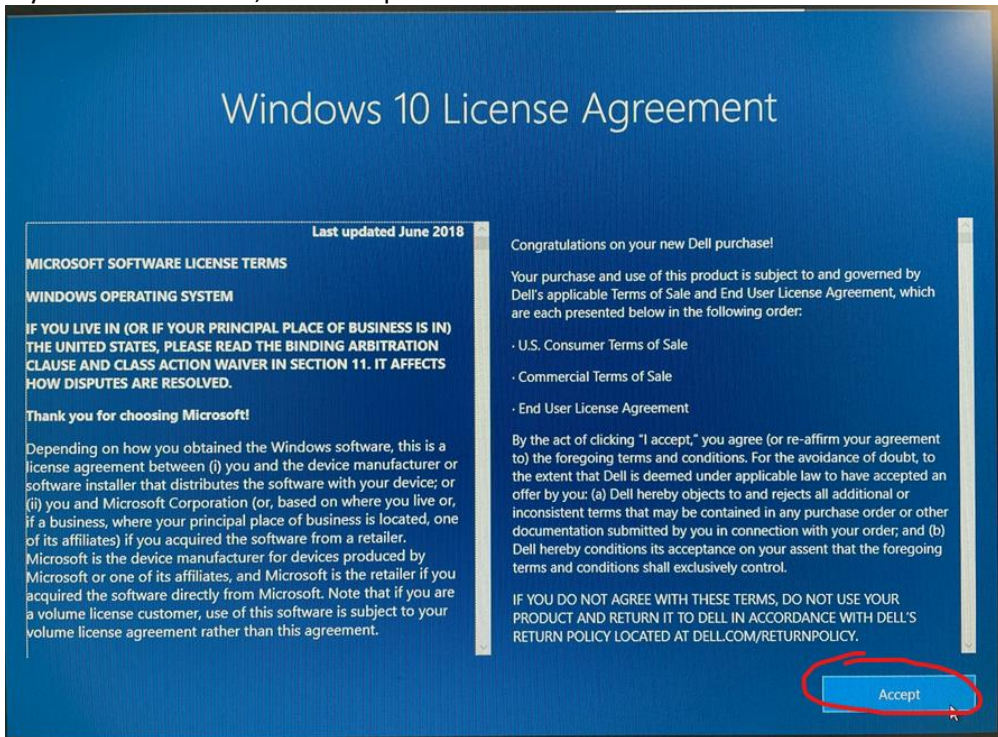

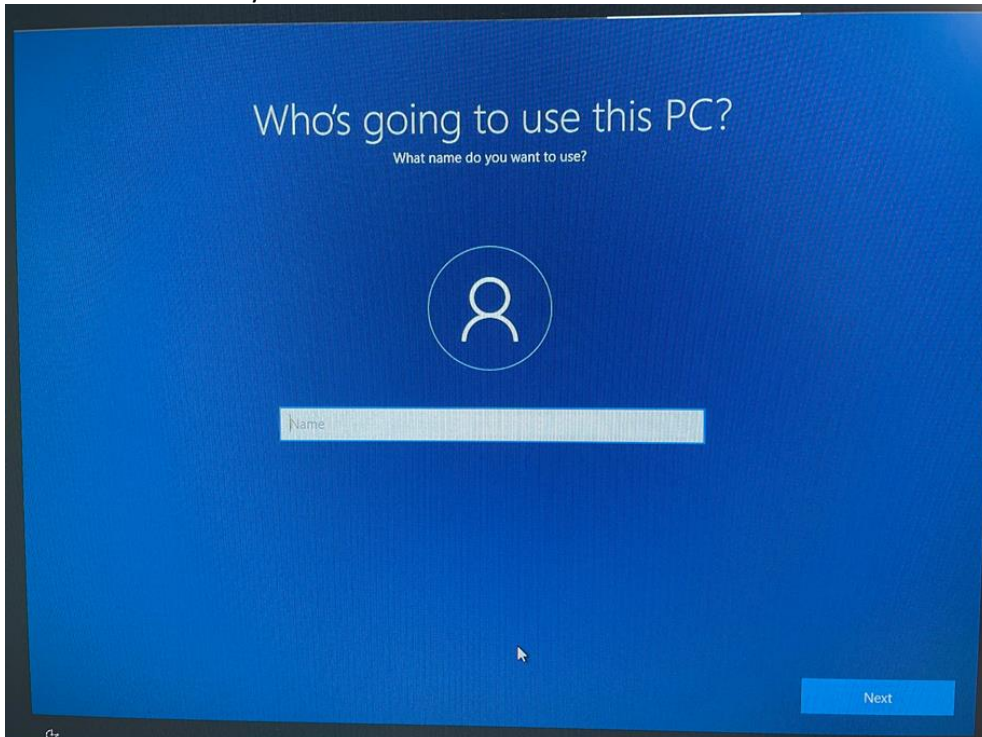
14) Just click Continue with limited setup



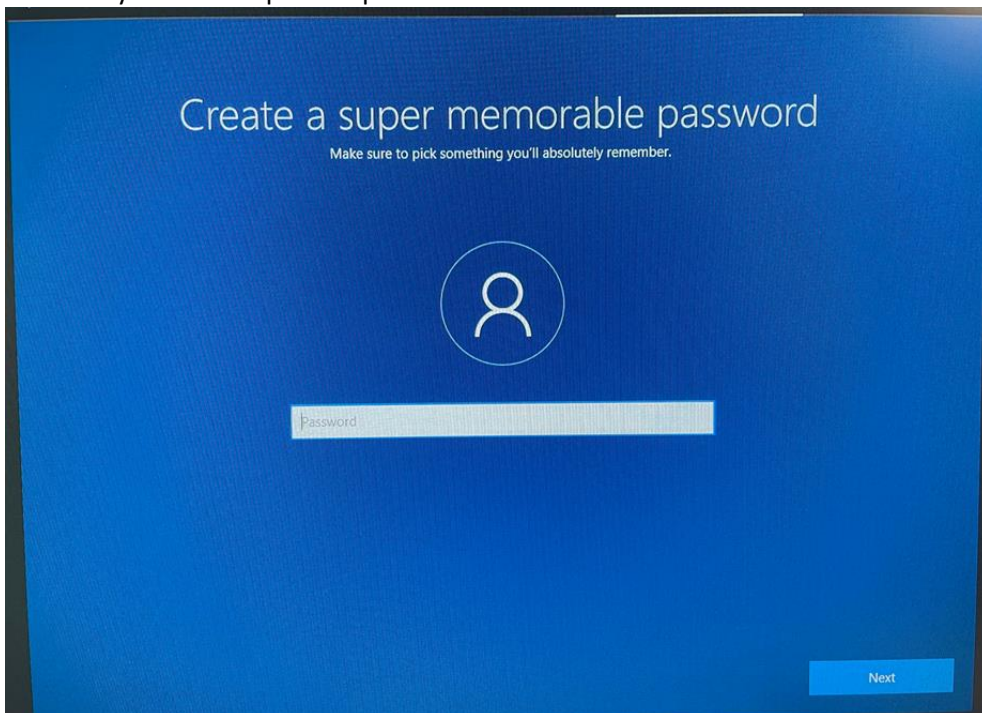
15) If you see this screen, click Accept



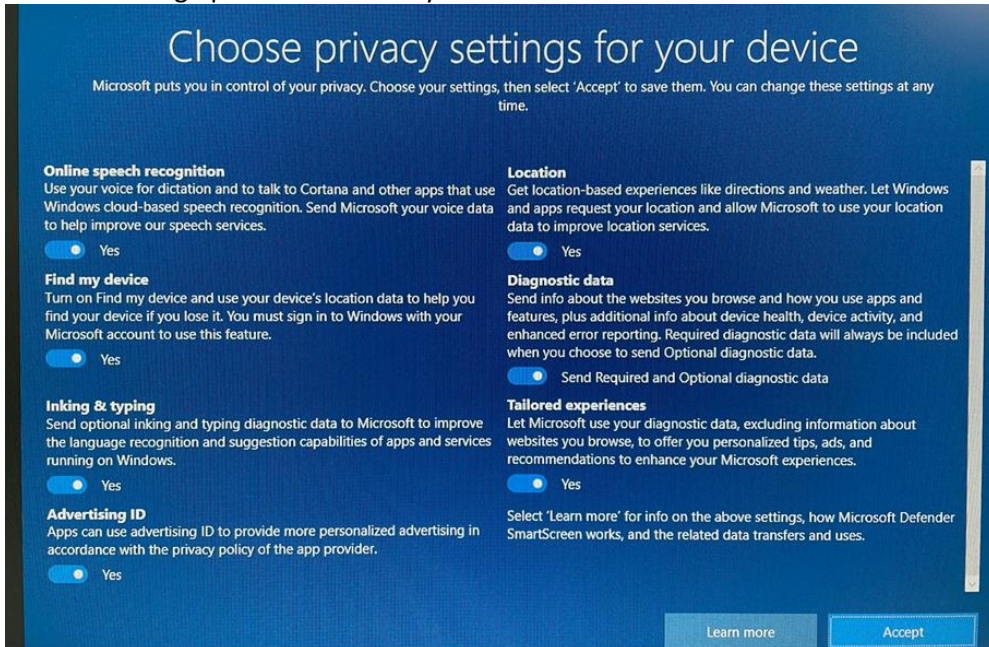

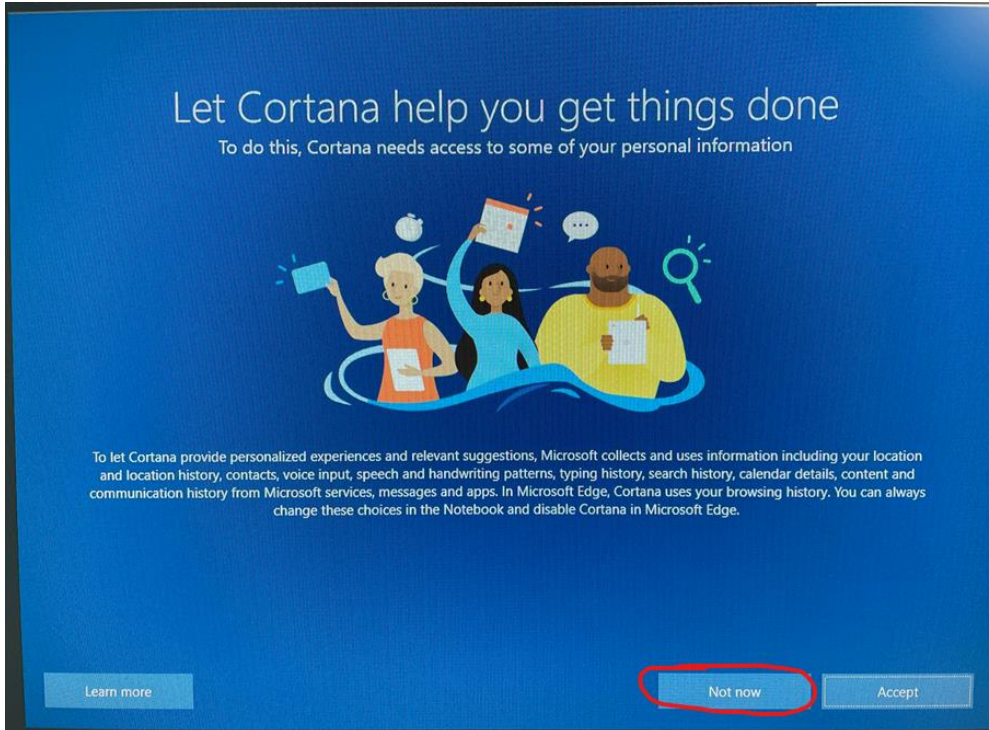
- 17) Decide if you want to put in a password or leave it blank
